BLACKWATER MINE —

We are steadily advancing our work at the Blackwater mine site, actively engaged in the structural, mechanical, and piping scope for the project. As we work our way to a successful completion, we look forward to the spring and summer seasons..

Congratulations to our dedicated and hard-working team at the Ascot Mine Project for reaching significant milestones this year. Our team installed over 18,000 ft. of process piping plus the fire protection system.

OAKRIDGE PROJECT -



Gisborne continues to provide fire protection installation services to all seven active towers for the Oakridge Project in Vancouver. At its peak, we aim to have approximately 30 workers on site. When completed, this project will create a new vibrant cultural district that incorporates retail, office, residential, cultural, and civic uses, and a new nine-acre landscaped rooftop park.
