## CITY OF LOUGHEED: FIRE PROTECTION SYSTEM INSTALLATION



Gisborne designed, supplied, and installed the Fire Protection System for four towers and an 8-level underground parkade, covering a footprint of 2,645,951 SF. We completed the project in just 40 months, three months ahead of schedule across all towers and coordinated with other trades to maintain the phased occupancy schedule. Our team achieved a safety record with zero incidents over 57,107 man-hours, successfully meeting all occupancy dates.

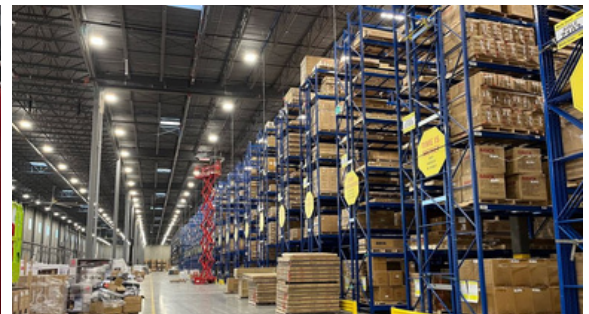


## ROYAL INLAND HOSPITAL'S TOWER RENOVATION UNDERWAY
