COR Certification



Underground construction and maintenance have been tasks that Gisborne has been performing at the Diavik mine. We have been onsite for over a decade. Recent work has included fabricating and installing dewatering galleries, pump stations, and underground fresh air raises, as well as relocating fresh air mine heater systems and refurbishing barges. Our team operates at significant depths, having reached approximately 575m at 418/154 PITs and currently working at 130m in A21 PIT.
