

As we enter 2025, Gisborne remains committed to maintaining the highest standards of quality in our operations. Our key objectives for the year include maintaining an average Project Quality Audit score of 93% or higher, enhancing our timely reporting of Quality Errors, and finalizing our Manitoba certification for ASME code piping installation. These goals reflect our ongoing dedication to continuous improvement in all aspects of our work.

In 2024, Gisborne achieved several key quality objectives led by Ken Scherellies and the team:

- Successfully implemented Quality Surveillance for CPVC pipe and fittings
- Improved timely reporting of Quality Errors
- Maintained a strong average Project Quality Audit score of 92.74%
- New Pressure Piping Manuals for Alberta, British Columbia, and Ontario
- Renewed Pressure Piping and Gas licenses in multiple provinces
- Successful ABSA Audit of our Quality Program in Alberta
- Development of new welding procedures for CWB and ASME work


For 2025, Gisborne has set ambitious Health, Safety, & Environmental (HSE) goals, aiming to improve upon our strong 2024 performance:


